The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development provides a shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and the planet. At its heart are the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), a comprehensive framework with specific targets to assist in the achievement of this overarching goal.

The following one page tools are designed to help provide a broad overview of each SDG, with information on each from the UN Sustainable Development Goals Framework*, as well as specific examples applicable to Volunteer Involving Organisations (VIOs).

Having clear, tangible targets and frameworks such as the SDGs, aids us as a global population in tracking collective progress and encouraging others to also take action.

By aligning your volunteer roles with SDGs, you can demonstrate how small local actions are contributing to the global big picture. You could also improve relevance for younger volunteers whose values may resonate with these global goals and a desire to make impactful change in the world.

It is possible that you can find a clear link between your volunteer program and the targets of a particular SDG. However, many activities are inherently quite intersectional and may align with multiple SDGs. For example a community food supply program could meet SDG 1: No Poverty. SDG 2: Zero Hunger, SDG 3: Good Health and Wellbeing, and SDG 10: Reduced Inequalities.

Many VIOs may already be achieving significant progress towards the SDGs without realising it!





1 NO POVERTY

End poverty in all its forms everywhere



Targets, by 2030:

- Eradicate extreme poverty, i.e. people living on less than \$1.25 a day
- Halve the proportion of men, women and children of all ages living in poverty
- Implement social protection systems and measures for all
- Ensure equal rights to economic & technology resources and basic services
- Build resilience to economic, social and environmental shocks and disasters

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve No Poverty?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, provide 5,000 free meals and 50 emergency accommodation beds by the end of next financial year.

Targets, by 2030:

- Universal access to safe and nutritious food
- End all forms of malnutrition
- Double the productivity and incomes of small-scale food producers
- Sustainable food production and resilient agricultural practices
- · Maintain genetic diversity in food production

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Zero Hunger?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, distribute 500 emergency food packages by the end of next calendar year.

3 GOOD HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages

Targets, by 2030:

- Reduce maternal mortality
- End all preventable deaths under 5 years of age
- Fight communicable diseases
- Reduce mortality from non-communicable diseases and promote mental health
- Prevent and treat substance abuse
- Reduce road injuries and deaths
- Universal access to sexual and reproductive care, family planning and education
- Achieve universal health coverage
- Reduce illnesses and death from hazardous chemicals and pollution

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Good Health and Well-Being?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, provide 200 nutritionally balanced school meals per month to lower socio-economic communities by the end of next financial year.

Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all



Targets, by 2030:

- Free primary and secondary education
- Equal access to quality pre-primary education
- Equal access to affordable technical, vocational and higher education
- Increase the number of people with relevant skills for financial success
- Eliminate all discrimination in education
- Universal literacy and numeracy
- Education for sustainable development and global citizenship

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Quality Education?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, facilitate 100 literacy/numeracy tutoring sessions in the coming academic year.

Targets, by 2030:

- End discrimination against women and girls
- End all violence against and exploitation of women and girls
- Eliminate forced marriages and genital mutilation
- Value unpaid care and promote shared domestic responsibilities
- Ensure full participation in leadership and decision-making
- Universal access to reproductive health and rights

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Gender Equality?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, advocate for and support the implementation of 5 menstrual product accessibility places within your community by the end of next calendar year.

Targets, by 2030:

- Safe and affordable drinking water
- End open defecation and provide access to sanitation and hygiene
- Improve water quality, wastewater treatment and safe reuse
- Increase water-use efficiency and ensure freshwater supplies
- Implement integrated water resources management
- Protect and restore water-related ecosystems

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Clean Water and Sanitation?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, conduct 6 marinedebris clean-up events by the end of next financial year.

- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Affordable and Clean Energy?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, facilitate 10 energy efficiency education sessions by the end of next calendar year.

Targets, by 2030:

- Sustainable economic growth
- Diversify, innovate and upgrade for economic productivity
- Promote policies to support job creation and growing enterprises
- Improve resource efficiency in consumption and production
- Full employment and decent work with equal pay
- Promote youth employment, education and training
- End modern slavery, trafficking and child labour
- Protect labour rights and promote safe working environments
- Promote beneficial and sustainable tourism
- Universal access to banking, insurance and financial services

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Decent Work and Economic Growth?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, support 10 young people with pathway programs by the end of next calendar year.

- Develop sustainable, resilient and inclusive infrastructures
- Promote inclusive and sustainable industrialisation
- Increase access to financial services and markets
- Upgrade all industries and infrastructure for sustainability
- Enhance research and upgrade industrial technologies

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, deliver 10 STEM education workshops in local schools in the coming school year.

- Adopt fiscal and social policies that promote equality
- Improved regulation of global financial markets and institutions
- Enhanced representation for developing countries in financial institutions
- Responsible and well-managed migration policies

- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Reduce Inequality?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, hold 5 language classes for recent migrants by the end of next calendar year.

- Protect the world's cultural and natural heritage
- Reduce the adverse effects of natural disasters
- Reduced the environmental impact of cities

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Sustainable Cities and Communities?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, dedicate 20 hours to a community garden working bee within the first half of next year.

Targets, by 2030:

- Implement the 10-year sustainable consumption and production framework
- Sustainable management and use of natural resources
- Halve global per capita food waste
- Responsible management of chemicals and waste
- Substantially reduce waste generation
- Encourage companies to adopt sustainable practices and sustainability reporting
- Promote sustainable public procurement practices
- Promote universal understanding of sustainable lifestyles

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Responsible Consumption and Production?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, run a food donation drive for a local free food pantry once a year.

- Build knowledge and capacity to meet climate change

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Climate Action?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, plant 1,000 native tree or shrubs by the end of next calendar year.

Targets, by 2030:

- Reduce marine pollution

- Sustainable fishing
- Conserve coastal and marine areas
- End subsidies contributing to overfishing
- Increase the economic benefits from sustainable use of marine resources

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Life Below Water?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, collect 100 kg of waste from waterway clean ups by the end of calendar year.

15 LIFE ON LAND

Protect, restore and promote sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, and halt and reverse land degradation and halt biodiversity loss



Targets, by 2030:

- Conserve and restore terrestrial and freshwater ecosystems
- End deforestation and restore degraded forests
- End desertification and restore degraded land
- Ensure conservation of mountain ecosystems
- Protect biodiversity and natural habitats
- Promote access to genetic resources and fair sharing of the benefits
- Eliminate poaching and trafficking of protected species
- Prevent invasive alien species on land and in water systems
- Integrate ecosystem and biodiversity in governmental planning

Does your volunteering opportunity align with this SDG?

- Review your program objectives, expected outputs and activities and reflect on these in relation to the SDG.
- Ask yourself: do the volunteering activities reflect the issue, ambition and scope of SDG targets to achieve Life on Land?
- Set a target or goal aligned to this SDG. For example, prevent the destruction of protected natural habitat between now and by the end of next financial year.

- Protect children from abuse, exploitation, trafficking and violence
- Promote the rule of law and ensure equal access to justice
- Combat organised crime and illicit financial and arms flows
- Substantially reduce corruption and bribery
- Develop effective, accountable and transparent institutions
- Ensure responsive, inclusive and representative decision-making
- Strengthen the participation in global governance
- Provide universal legal identity
- Ensure public access to information and protect fundamental freedoms
